Services

One to one training sessions.

These are usually carried out in your home, where most problems originate but can be carried out in a variety of places dependent on yours and your dog's needs.

Behavioural analysis of your dog with advice, practice & experience of handling techniques.

Real life training classes.

Which provide an opportunity to train & socialise your dog/puppy in a variety of locations with other well-suited dogs.

(NB. A one to one session is recommended before you join a class.)

Prices

The charge is £40 per one to one session. (Subject to location)
Each session lasts approximately an hour.

Attendance to Real life training Classes cost £10 a class. (Again these last approximately one hour)

Training sessions are determined by your requirements and your dogs needs. You can have as many or as few sessions as you wish. There is no minimum course length.
